CIRCULAR

Subject: Recovery for not maintaining 80:20 ratio in Deltamethrin and Malathion in PEG godowns.

Ref: FCI, Headquarters Circular no. QC-19(10-A)/91/R&D dated 30.11.1998 (copy enclosed)

The matter regarding recovery for not maintaining 80:20 ratio of Deltamethrin and Malathion in PEG godowns has been examined in consultation with QC division of FCI Headquarters, which has opined that change in QC instructions cannot be allowed and the extant instruction circulated by QC division of FCI, Headquarters vide circular dated 30.11.1998 (copy enclosed) for maintaining 80:20 ratio should be followed uniformly. Para II of Model Agreement of Guarantee to be executed between Nodal Agency and FCI for PEG godowns constructed through private investors, clearly entails that nodal agency would "provide services including but not confined to preservation, maintenance, security, handling and insurance as per the existing standards of services being rendered to FCI and in accordance with instructions issued by Govt. of India / FCI".

In view of above, it has been decided that henceforth compliance of extant QC instruction dated 30.11.1998 should be ensured in PEG godowns also without fail. Non-compliance of the said instructions may attract recovery/deductions in future on account of losses caused, if any and saving of chemical etc.

This issues with the approval of competent authority.

Sir,

Please refer to the circular cited above. After taking note of results of further experiment conducted on use of Deltamethrin and also considering the request from the field it has been decided to increase the use of Deltamethrin in place of Malathion as prophylactic treatment to 80% of foodgrains in storage, taking into consideration of over all cost effectiveness of this chemical. The remaining 20% of stocks will continue to receive Malathion treatment.

The details of use of Deltamethrine are reproduced below again for the guidance of field staff.
